

- Launched by Tun Haji Abdul Razak Hussien (2nd Prime Minister of Malaysia)



International Case Study Washington Park, Milwaukee

Introduction



- Host to a large lagoon and natural area
- Known as West Park at 18th centuries designed as a ZOO.
 Year 1900 it became Washington Park.

History

- Was founded in 1891
- Located in Wisconson, Milwaukee
- Was originally named West Park
- Designed by Frederick Law Olmsted
- Landscapes and recreational activities promote both the physical and mental health of its visitors
- West Park became Washington Park in 1900 to reflect the importance of American history
 - After that, the park expanded to 132 acres
- In 2007, the Urban Ecology Center chose Washington Park for its satellite facility.
- Offer participants the opportunity to explore nature and experience
- West park zoo began in 1892
- In 1900, both park and zoo was renamed Washington Park
- By the 1930s, the zoological garden starts to wear
- The Washington Park Zoo fell silent in 1963 as the animals were moved to the new facility


